- Prioritise initiatives aimed at continual improvement through pollution prevention, biodiversity protection, efficient use of resources and energy in alignment with international standards and best practices.
- Follow waste management hierarchy — Prevent, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle and Recover in the Treatment & Disposal of waste and Implement strategies to promote circular economy to conserve natural resources.
